
Objectives

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

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Deliverables and Milestones

- Deliverables: concrete outputs and evidence of the work
- Good deliverables:"finished" products (e.g. a common call or a common programme, not just a workshop report)
- Milestones: key points in the process (e.g. workshop to define a joint call, publication of a joint call):
 - Their timing can coincide with that of a deliverable
 - There can be more milestones than deliverables

















Organisational Structure

- Network Steering Committee (N.S.C)
 - 1 Representative per Partner
 - 2 Meetings per year chaired by the Coordinator
 - Role: decision making and arbitration body of the EU-SEC II Consortium
- Secretariat (UNICRI)
 - Management of administrative, legal, financial aspects
 - Assistance to N.S.C
 - Drafting of Reports
- Coordinator (see next slide)
